EDUCATE: Leckey Forum: Release of the Northern Virginia Zoning Atlas

The *Virginia Zoning Atlas* is a research project of HousingForward Virginia with support from the Mercatus Center at George Mason University. This year's Leckey Forum will celebrate the release of the Northern Virginia component of the Atlas, an ongoing collaborative effort to map and standardize zoning across the Commonwealth. The Atlas helps visualize the impact of zoning on housing development and allows for cross-jurisdictional comparisons for deeper zoning analysis. It will enable comparisons across jurisdictions, illuminate regional and statewide trends, and strengthen national planning for housing production, transportation infrastructure, and climate response.
